-Delinquent Taxes \$119,610.26, Water \$3,684.82, Sewer \$9,626.06

-Sewer Plant completion estimate (includes paving and landscaping) June 2017.

-Paving grant for Chelsea Road two sections (Rte 14 to above Box 361 and Baptist Street to end of Pavement) Total cost is \$200,000.00 have applied for paving grant for \$160,000.00 of cost if approved. Have \$244,000.00 in paving reserve fund.

-Brockway Hill Road paving project drainage issue per easement agreement for sewer line upgrade project. \$4200.00.

-Better Back Roads Grant applied for \$10,000.00 towards the road erosion assessment of the Town of Williamstown. If approved will follow the guidance of ACT 64 and the draft Municipal Roads General Permit.

-Working with CVRPC on the re-write of the Flood Hazard Bylaws.
