Special Meeting Minutes

Present: John Perkins, CH, Susan Lyons, Matt Couillard, Orvil Lasell.

The above members met in the Village Cemetery at 9:00 A.M. for the purpose of removing the flags and to make a decision on the bids for the tree removal in East Hill Cemetery.

New Business:

The flags were removed and several items were discussed.

#1 The two bids received on the removal of a Maple tree in the East Hill Cemetery were reviewed and it was agreed that we would go with Jeremy Haggett's from the Vermont Expert Tree & Landscaping, Inc. for the price of \$1,300.00. The second bid was from Marshfield Tree Service & Logging, Inc. at \$2,500.00. Susan will notify Mr. Haggett on Monday and get a date for the removal to be completed.

#2 Orvil had removed the flags from the East Hill Cemetery and Susan had removed the flags from the West Hill Cemetery. All flags given to John Perkins.

#3 Orvil noticed a stone laid down in the Moses Ring plot in the Village Cemetery. This will need to be looked into next year. Range 1, Lot 10, Book A, Page 7. Check into Blanche Bailey's stone also. N. Add. Range 3, Lot 5, Book A, Page 88.

#4 Also looked at was the bank that was deteriorating in the East Range section of Village Cemetery. Possibly will need more grout to hold it.

#5 Woodchuck holes in Village – Joe is supposed to use something to get rid of them. Will need to fill in the holes under the stones next year. Also, he can lock the gates. Cemeteries are closed for this year – no further burials.
