Thank you for your interest in purchasing a lot in one of our cemeteries in Williamstown. The following is some information that we thought may help in the decision to purchase a lot and also what you may need to know after you have purchased one.

- Price for a full lot is \$850.00 and a cremation lot is \$650.00. These prices include the purchase and installation of 4 corner posts.
- Each full lot is 5 feet by 10 feet and cremation lot is 5 feet by 5 feet.
- One full lot allows for 1 full burial and 2 cremations or a total of 4 cremations and a cremation lot allows for two cremations.
- A non-resident/non-relative must pay an additional burial fee of \$125.00 for the interment.
- For a cremation, if a durable cremation vault or urn isn't used, you will need to sign a release that the cremains will not be recoverable.
- Foundations for a monument must be designated by the Commission. It must be 4' deep, unless the monument is 2' by 1' or smaller in which case it must be 3' deep.
- Monuments_cannot be larger than 3' 6" long.
- For any work to be done in the cemetery, a Work Order Permit must be obtained from the Town Clerk's Office.
- If you are using a grass marker instead of a large monument, it costs \$60.00 for it to be installed and must be installed by the Cemetery Commission.
- The interment rates for Weekdays are: Full Burial \$800.00

, ,	Cremation	\$400.00
Weekends are:		\$900.00
	Cremation	\$500.00

- There is an additional fee for grave opening if there are unforeseen problems at the grave site (ledge, water, etc.). An additional charge is also made when the time of arrival or duration of a funeral necessitates payment for overtime labor or if unusual circumstances warrant additional charges.
- Before a burial can take place, a Grave Opening Authorization form must be completed. This can be obtained from the Town Clerk's Office.
- If you wish to obtain a copy of the Rules and Regulations of the Williamstown Cemetery's you can do so at the Town Clerk's Office.
- Rose bushes are not allowed in the cemeteries.
