Set the Agenda: Tabled the Warrant Approvals

New Business: Saldi Field and the area on the other side of the berm that is owned by the Town was toured and inspected by the Selectboard members and Rob Townsend, to determine whether or not the Town owned portion that is adjacent to the field would be a suitable site for a parking lot during Williamstown Youth Sports events. This area was being considered due to the safety concerns when the current parking lot overflows and parked cars of attendees block the only road in and out of the field, which has created difficult situations for emergency services in the past.

The Town owned portion in question used to be the Town dump several years ago, and since then it has been capped and continuously tested for contaminants on a bi-annual basis. It was determined during the site visit that since the area could not have any structures built upon it for environmental reasons, and that the area already had a road leading to it, that could be accessed from the current transfer station, that it would make a suitable area to use for parking for Williamstown Youth Sports' larger events.

Scott McCarthy made a motion to approve Williamstown Youth Sport's request to use the portion of Town owned land adjacent to Saldi Field as a secondary parking area for their events. **Clayton Woodworth** seconded the motion. **Cote Griggs** recused himself, as he is a current member of Williamstown Youth Sports; so, moved.
